DESEIMI 2010 Design Study for a European Infrastructure of Mathematics for Innovation

- **Idea: A network math for industry following the recommendations of the forward look**
- Coordination and Support Actions – (CSA-CA)
- **Partners: ESF, EMS, U. Lund, MATHEON Berlin, U. Firenze, Fondation Mathematique Paris**
- **Failed despite appeal, by not having a European dimension.**
- **Many talks with EU Officials followed.**



VEIMI 2011: **Virtual e-Infrastructure of Mathematics for *Innovation***

- *Coordination and Support Actions (CSA-CA or CSA-SA)*

Partners: EMS, U. Lund, MATHEON Berlin, Fondazione per la Ricerca e l'Innovazione, AMIES France, ICM Warsaw

- **Failed due to low marks on the basis of not been interactive enough in the development, budget too small to achieve goals.**
- **Many further talks with EU Officials followed.**
