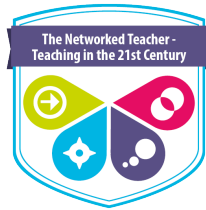

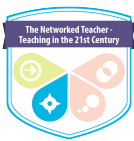

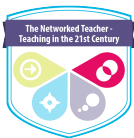
1. Reflecting on how the job of a teacher will look

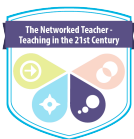
1. Getting acquainted with the concept of active learning
